## **Attending Sunday In-Person Indoor Worship (in the Sanctuary)**

Here's what you need to know!

## USE CDC GUIDELINES TO ASSESS YOUR READINESS TO WORSHIP WITH US INSIDE THE SANCTUARY:

- Please consider getting your Covid-19 vaccination before attending worship indoors.
- **Stay home if you have been exposed** to someone with Covid-19 in the last 2 weeks, if you have travelled to an area with high covid prevalence, and/or if you're exhibiting symptoms of illness.
- If you **unknowingly attend worship while you are Covid-19 positive**, please contact the church office so we can communicate a possible exposure to our church family. Your identity and privacy will be protected.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING WORSHIP:

- **There will be no congregational singing** to begin. We know this is disappointing, but with transmission mostly through the air, we're going to be cautious. During worship enjoy listening to our soloist. **Joyful humming** is encouraged!
- **Holy Communion:** You are welcome to bring your own bread and wine/juice from home OR a disposable cup will be provided with a small wafer and juice.
- **Service Length:** The service will be shorter...30-40 minutes.
- Offering: There will be a locked offering box for you to leave your offering. There are no pens in the pews. You may want to write your checks at home before you come. Pens WILL be near the offering box.
- **The worship folder** will have everything no need for hymnals.
- Please arrive between 9:50 and 10:00.
- A Children's Sermon will occur immediately following the service.

## LOGISTICS:

- **Everyone must be masked** both in the building and in the parking lot. If you forget a mask, one will be provided to you.
- Stay socially distanced at least 6 feet apart from non-family members.
- Enter the building through the main (front) sanctuary doors.
- Socially distanced seating will be marked. Please sit with your household only.
- **Please do NOT circulate around the room**. We need everyone to enter, find, and keep their seats.
- **Everyone will be stationary.** Stay at your seats for passing the peace and communion.
- **We will dismiss people out the side door** and through the breezeway in an orderly fashion that allows for social distancing.
- **Try not to use the restrooms** if possible. If you do use the restroom, look for a sign with instructions on how to sanitize the space afterwards.
- The sanctuary will be sanitized weekly between worship services.
- We will livestream the service. Video will also be available soon afterwards.
- Attendance will be limited to 92 for now.
